## **CHILDREN'S PROGRAM**

The children's program is designed for children from 7 - 11 years old; however, other children may be admitted upon skill and maturity evaluation. As students mature and learn basic skills, they may be invited to additional advanced practices within the sole discretion of Troy D. Ferguson Sensei. While regular training will certainly fluctuate throughout the year, the best progress is made when attending at least two classes each week on a consistent basis.

In the children's class, all formalities are the same as the adult class, and students are expected to follow the dojo's rules of conduct and etiquette to promote a safe and respectful dojo environment.

### **Ranking**

Unlike the adult classes, colored belts are given as a way to provide visual encouragement for advancing. Kids start out as 7<sup>th</sup> kyu and work their way up, with the dojo's goal of having them attain at least 3<sup>rd</sup> kyu by the time they are ready to join the adult class at age 12-15.

Competition does not play any role in the examination. The test is structured on the students' demonstration of the proper Aikido spirit, proficiency in Aikido techniques, including weapons, knowledge of Japanese terminology, class attendance, the ability to follow directions and demonstration of continuously performing both right and left sides until called to stop. Ferguson Sensei decides when the children are ready to be tested and have earned the right to be tested. Testing is a privilege and an objective mechanism to gauge one's progress in Aikido.

## **CHILDREN'S WEAPONS PROGRAM**

### **1. Aiki Ken (Wooden Sword)**

Children will learn the seven bokken suburi, the seven basic strikes with the boken or wooden sword, migo no awase, hidari no awase and go no awase.

### **2. Aiki Jo (Short Staff)**

Children will learn the twenty jo suburi, the twenty basic strikes with the jo or short staff and the 31 jo kata. The 20 jo suburi are as follows:

### **RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS**

In consideration of being permitted to study and practice the martial art of AIKIDO and to attend and participate in the Aikido classes and seminars offered by AIKIKAI INTERNATIONAL, INC., at the A. Kolychkine Judo Foundation, Inc., located at 9664 Sunset Drive, Miami, Florida 33173, Releasor, for himself/herself and personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, hereby releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue AIKIKAI INTERNATIONAL, INC., A. Kolychkine Judo Foundation, Inc., and their officers, directors, employees, members and training instructors, all referred to as Releasees, from all liability to the Releasor, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin, for all loss or damage, and any claim or damage therefor, on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the Releasor, whether caused by the negligence of Releasees, or otherwise, while the Releasor is studying or practicing or, for any purpose, participating in the art of AIKIDO during the above-referenced Aikido classes and seminars.

Releasor agrees to indemnify the Releasees and each of them for any loss, liability, damage or cost Releasees may incur due to the presence of Releasor in or on the area designated for the study and practice of AIKIDO at the A. Kolychkine Judo Foundation, Inc., located at 9664 Sunset Drive, Miami, Florida 33173, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

Releasor understands that his/her participation in the study and practice of AIKIDO is voluntary and at his/her own risk and expense. Releasor also understands that the practice of AIKIDO involves bodily contact and the use of weapons and has an inherent risk of injury.

Releasor hereby assumes full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death or property damage due to negligence of Releasees, or otherwise, while in or on the aforementioned area designated for the study and practice of AIKIDO, and/or while studying, practicing or for any purpose participating in AIKIDO.



Releasor expressly agrees that this release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Florida and that, if any portion of the agreement is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding continue in full legal force and effect.

## **Dues Policy**

**(Effective December 31, 2015)**

Aikido dojo dues are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed to any dues received after the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month. If paying by check or money order, you may mail your payment to the address above, but the payment must be received by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month to avoid the late fee. Out of respect to Ferguson Sensei and the dojo, no member shall be allowed to train if he/she is in delinquent status. If your dues are late by twenty (20) days, your dojo membership will automatically terminate without further notice, and you will have to reapply to the dojo to reinstate your membership.
